Coaches/Managers/Assistants

- Place the well-being, safety & enjoyment of each player above everything else
- Always show respect to everyone involved in the game
- Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of the game
- Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour
- Never coach your team alone
- Avoid taking any players in your car to training or games
- Ensure my DBS and coaching qualifications are kept up to date
- Give all players, whatever their ability, the chance to play
- Ensure the coaching sessions are fun, suited to the players ability & age, are well-structured to develop players skill, decision-making and understanding of the game
- Always respect the referee and encourage players to do the same
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, racist, insulting or abusive behaviour
- Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on others
- Be gracious in victory and defeat
- Respect the equipment that is provided to you by the club
- Wear Club coaches kit when representing the club
- Make sure my players & myself have completed a medical form that must be kept with the team at all times
- Respect away team facilities
- Report any concerns or signs of abuse/bullying/neglect to the Club Welfare Officer

I understand that if I do not follow the these rules, I may be:

- Required to meet with the Club Chairman & Welfare Officer
- Suspended or fined by the club
- Suspended or fined by Beds FA
- Required to leave, lose my position and/or have my license withdrawn
